- 5. To encourage them to switch off all the appliances and lights when not in use.
- 6. To spread awareness about the advantages of pollution free environment.

Highlights: -

1. The college organised a tree planting event on 7th June 2022. As a part of the Environment Day celebrations the main purpose of this programme was to make students aware about the fact plants play a big role in our ecosystem by

maintaining a balance and also helps to keep in check the climatic conditions of a place.

- 2. The director of college Dr. Surekha Jichkar and Flying officer Prof. Prapti Barde were invited as the chief guests of this event and to help the college, to promote the importance of planting trees and protecting the environment. The tree planting program started around 10:00 a.m., just after the morning assembly.
- 3. The first tree was planted by the Director of the college and Prof. Prapti Barde in the college campus. Five different groups of the junior students was created and were given 10 saplings to plant in and around the college campus, and the remaining saplings were planted by the senior students along with the faculty members in the local areas around the school.
- 4. After planting the saplings, the Dr. Surekha Jichkar gave a speech on why planting trees can prove to be beneficial for the environment. Her speech included subjects like how human beings get ample oxygen because of trees and how cutting down trees mercilessly has impacted the environment adversely.
- 5. She also advised that if future generations wanted to enjoy Mother Earth's resources and privileges, then it's important that they plant and save trees and protect our environment.
- 6. Prof. Prapti Barde also expressed her views on the importance of Tree Plantation and ended the event with a vote of thanks by appreciating the Director and the students for their presence.
- 7. Prof. Rutuja Budhe and Dr. Vikram Dongre, Dr. Ujwala Narkede, Prof. Harish Kutemate, Mrs. Mangla Golhar and Ms. Komal Meshram worked hard to make the event a grand success.
